Where: The SCRR is located south of I-94, Hudson WI.

- From exit #2 I-94 (County Road F, Carmichael Road) head 4.2 miles south
- Turn Right (West) on South Cove Road, along the north edge of Troy Burne golf course
- Turn right (North) at the stop sign (still South Cove Road) to the bottom of the hill
- Turn left (West) on Croix Ridge Drive. The SCRR driveway is the first turning on the left.
- The address is 315 Croix Ridge Drive, Hudson, WI. 50416

Facilities: The SCRR has three tracks

- An elevated track supporting 2½", 3½", 4¾" and 5"-gauge tracks.
- A ground level 4¾ inch featuring a 2,200′ 1.5% grade
- A ground level 7½ inch gauge

Track clearances and specifications are documented on the SCRR website.

Steaming bay facilities with water, compressed air and 120V electricity is available. Coal and propane are available onsite at cost. Unloading facilities include an electric hoist and willing hands! Hours for unloading/loading are 8 AM to 10 PM., if you need to unload or load outside these times please check with Meet Chairperson. Check the posted notice at the registration building for more info.

Covered areas will be available for stationary equipment and displays. Please contact us with your needs.

Safety Inspections:

- All locomotives and rolling stock are subject to be checked for gage prior to being run at the SCRR. The SCRR conforms to IBLS standards for wheel profile, thickness and flange depth. Non-conforming equipment will not be allowed to operate on the track due to the potential for track damage. This includes SCRR domiciled locomotives and rolling stock.
- All steam locomotives, steam tractors, and stationary boilers must have up-to-date boiler inspection documentation meaning the last boiler inspection cannot be more than two (2) years old. If you need a boiler inspection the SCRR will have inspectors on site. Upon registering please let the registrar know that you need a boiler inspection. Note that an SCRR inspection for visiting equipment is a safety action on behalf of the SCRR; we do not purport to be any form of certifying organization and will not be issuing any certificates for visiting equipment.
- All steam locomotives and stationary boilers that burn solid fuels (coal, wood, briquettes) must have a functioning ash pan.

Railroad Operations:

- All tracks open for operation between 6 AM and Midnight
- No whistles or horns may be used before 9 AM and after 9 PM
- Night running on any night, weather permitting
- You must display a headlight and a "FRED" (red lights face rear)
- See rules posted at the railroad

Volunteers are needed: Local and Distance Members are sought to help with the meet in food service, cleaning, loading, unloading, steaming bay and roundhouse duty. Contact Meet chairmen at the email address or phone number listed below or at the Meet when you arrive.

Friends and Guests: Of members are welcome at the Meet. All attendees including members must register and pay a registration fee. Members are responsible for their guests & friends' behavior and adherence to the safety rules of the St. Croix Railroad.

Animal Friends: Are allowed <u>on a leash</u>. The pet owner is responsible for the behavior of the pet. The owner of any pet that is deemed to be a nuisance or unruly may be requested to remove the pet from the property. <u>Pet owners are responsible for picking up after the pet</u>.

Accommodations at or near SCRR

Limited space for RV's and travel trailers are available at the SCRR. Maximum <u>overall Total length</u> is 30 foot. You must call or email <u>campingrequest@stcroixrr.org</u> prior to May 17th to reserve a spot. Limited electric hookup is available on a first come first served basis. Tent Camping spots are located on the grounds around the railroad. Heated bathrooms and showers are available on site for campers. Please limit your shower time as a courtesy to other campers and also to ensure hot water for all. We suggest a donation of \$10.00 per night for RV's and \$5.00 per night for Tenting.

Camping nearby, River Falls WI

Available at Hoffman Park are 15 overnight camping spots with electric hook-up. The park is open from April 15 through October 15. Bathrooms, shower, water, and a dump station are available. Fee per night is \$20. Campsites are on a first come, first serve basis. They do not accept reservations. Campers are required to prepay into the yellow mailbox as sites are checked daily for valid occupancy. Free Wifi.

Local motels are in Hudson, WI and their phone numbers are shown below. The SCRR does not have any relationship with any of these businesses and cannot guarantee that space will be available so please call in advance. The SCRR is four miles south of Hudson which is approximately eighteen miles due east of downtown Saint Paul.
