St Croix Railroad 2017 work sessions – the “SCRR Summer Camp”

- Purpose
 - For the betterment of the St. Croix Railroad by providing a concentrated series of days where work can be performed without the concern for returning the railroad or railroads to service at the end of the day. We have a number of volunteers who want to come and help work on the railroad – this is a chance to do just that.
- Food Services
 - There will be no daily formal food services during these work weeks, however the cooking facilities of the St. Croix Railroad will be made available to responsible attendees that may wish to organize something. On Friday evening of each work week there will be a Pot Luck Dinner held at 6 PM. Bottled drinking water will be provided.
- Projects
 - Primarily projects & tasks will be work from the current projects and tasks list, however we will not necessarily be limited to that list.
- Railroad’s availability for operation
 - If you are bringing locomotives and rolling stock to operate on any of the St. Croix Railroads, please understand that some projects can take one or all of the railroads out of service for periods of time during the week. Every attempt will be made to minimize these down times and when possible advance posting of these down times will be done. These down times will be kept to a minimum.
- All Attendees need to bring, PPE, Personal Protective Equipment
 - Since most all projects and tasks involve manual labor and working around powered equipment, as well as getting dirty in some manner or other, members and guests must bring their own Personal Protective Gear, Safety glasses, gloves, foot wear, sunscreen, bug repellent and appropriate clothing for working in the outdoors. In the event of rain we have plenty of indoor projects and tasks to work on.
- Children
 - Children are welcome to work alongside their parents, grandparents, or guardian; however we do ask that you evaluate your child’s interest in contributing to the work session and your child’s abilities when selecting projects that you will work on with your child. We cannot provide daycare services and it is likely that there will be machinery and other activities that would make kids that are just “tagging along” a liability. We strongly recommend children that do not have an interest in working not attend.
- Registration
 - In order to keep track of members and guest in attendance during these work weeks ALL members and guest must fill out a simple registration form. All attendees will have a tag to wear to show they are registered for the work sessions. A list will be maintained of all attendees at the member’s desk in the Main Building at the Railroad.
- Cost
 - Where the focus is on working on the railroads and property and the end result is improve the St Croix Railroad there will be no registration fee or camping fee during this time for those that come to work.
- Camping at the SCRR
 - Limited space for RV’s and travel trailers is available at the SCRR on first come first served bases. Maximum **overall Total length is 30 foot.** Limited electric hook up is available on a first come first served bases. Tent Camping spots are located on the grounds around the railroad. Heated bathrooms and showers are available on site for campers.
